**COURT ORDER**

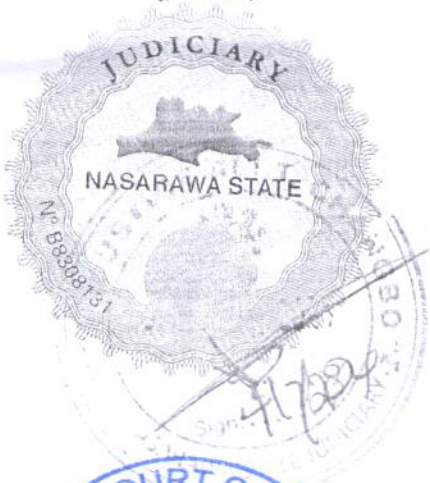

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. AN ORDER IS HEREBY MADE granting leave to the Applicants to apply for the orders of certiorari, prohibition and injunction quashing the ruling delivered by the 1st Respondent at the Upper Area Court Karu II, Masaka, Nasarawa State in case No. UAC/KRII/CR.30/2024 between OBISCO INTEGRATED SERVICES LTD & ANOR. Vs J. POCCO INTEGRATED SERVICES & ANOR. Wherein the 1st Respondent assumed jurisdiction in a case outside his jurisdictional power and competence.
2. AN ORDER IS FURTHER MADE that the leave so granted shall operate as a stay of further proceedings in case No. UACKRII/CR.30./2024 between OBISCO INTEGRATED SERVICES LTD & ANOR. Vs J. POCCO INTEGRATED SERVICES & ANOR. Pending before the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent.
